## Ridership Table Notes

- Line 11: Washburn ridership is down 38% from 2017 levels YTD. A reduction in the number of foreign students enrolled is a likely casue.
- Lines 21 & 25: The shift from TMTA paratranist services to CCT continues.
- Total ridership of 120,600 is the highest monthly rideship in planning tracking spreadsheet (began January 2011)

## Long-Range Transit Plan Update

- The second round of the MetroQuest survey launched launched August 20th and will continue until September 30th. Promotional efforts include social media, email, online ads, and face-to-face public outreach.
- The second Steering Committee meeting will be held 12:15- 1:45 pm September 18th.
