• Line 19: Ridership for FY 2018 exceeded the previous year by 2%.


• Line 8: While lower than in June 2017, June numbers are in line with the 5 year average for the 'Student' category.

Long-Range Transit Plan Update

- Staff is working with AECOM to finalize 'Existing Conditions' portion of plan by mid-July.
- The first Steering Committee meeting will be held July 16th.
- Work has begun on writing the 'Develop Priorities' and "Budget Priorities" section for the Phase II MetroQuest survey.

Route 5 extension in August

- Route 5 will be extended to 33rd and Arrowhead (just west of Gage) with the August service update.
- This will provide full schedule service to a section of southwest Topeka previously served by the 29 Special.
